Dear Parents,

Please keep in mind that if your child just started with us, is absent or if your child attends part time that they won't have as many projects or a large amount of work completed as we have been keeping them since the start of your child's start date. We are looking forward to seeing your families at Open House. The Preschool Staff is excited to announce our **OPEN HOUSE** on Thursday, May 9th, from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Preschool will close on that date at 12:00 p.m. in order for staff to prepare for Open House. For any child picked up after 12:00, late fees will apply. Please mark your calendar to attend, and your family is welcome. The School will have a dinner the night of Open House starting at 5:30 p.m. More information will be sent home closer to the date.

Preschool registration for the Fall is here! If you plan on having your child attend Preschool in the Fall, please return the registration form. For priority registration, please turn in your child's application and fees by Monday, March 4, 2019. After March 4th preschool spots will be given on a first come basis.

We will be offering Summer School again this year. We will offer Full Day, School Day and Half Days. Please return the registration form with the fee quickly as space is limited. It will be going home in April.

Kindergarten testing has started and will continue to the end of May. If your child is being tested, please make sure your child has plenty of rest the night before and a good breakfast. It helps them to be able to concentrate as they take the test.

Please let me know if you are planning on having your child tested. We will not be able to hold a spot for your child if you have not turned in your Kindergarten application.

Teaching children to give their feelings a name and how to handle their emotions is crucial to helping them love God and love others. Developing emotional awareness and how it relates to spiritual growth allows emotional and spiritual maturity to live out the fruit, self-control. Talking to your children and their feelings will also allow a deeper relationship between you and your child to create the foundation needed at the adolescent stage. Being emotionally safe with our kids provides calm to the fear center of their brain - allowing them to make wise decisions in overwhelming situations.
